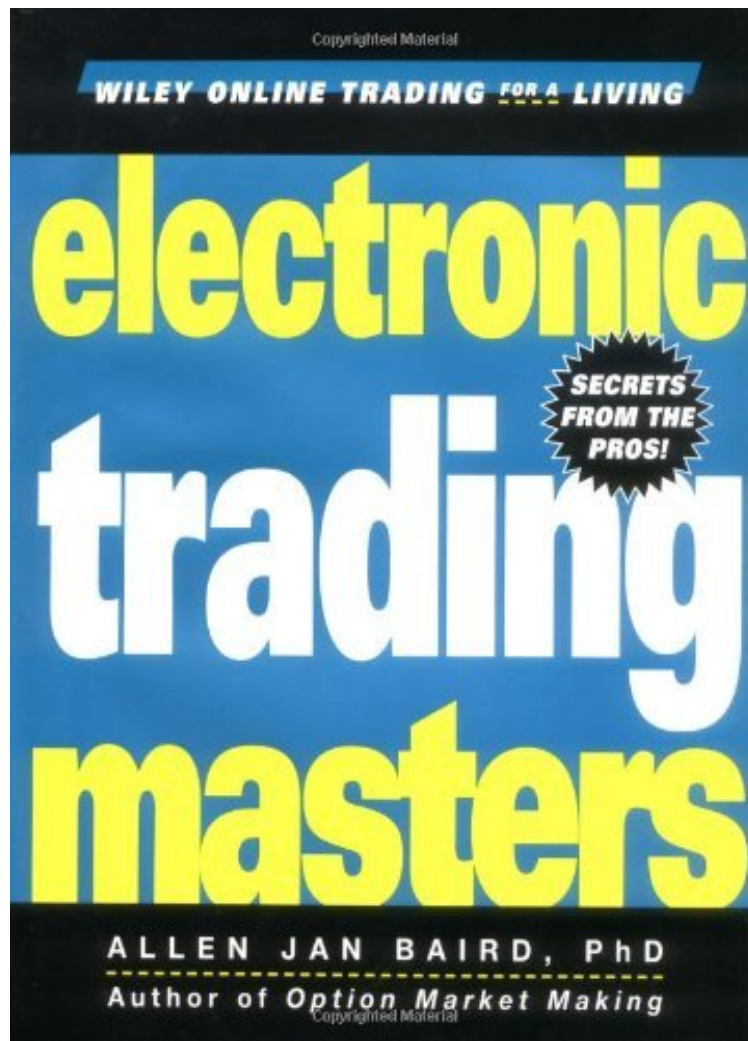

Has Baird picked the right guys? Only time will tell. It is a fun read, full of anecdotal stuff.
